***A Note about the Schedule ...*** New arrivals and those who have exhibited rebellious attitudes will remain on the Ranch full time. Individuals who have been at the Ranch for a period of two weeks or better and who exhibit willing attitudes towards restoration, will be permitted to go off the premises on supervised work details within the community.

## ***U-Turn Goals***

Within 2 to 3 months, residents are expected to be ready to move from Phase 1 to Phase 2, Phase 2 is a continuation of Phase 1 but with added responsibility and accountability. Within 15 days those in Phase 2 are expected to be gainfully employed and paying a modest room and board (to teach financial responsibility), Good attitudes, evident growth & maturity & compliance with ranch rules & work ethics, grant the privilege to graduate to the Phase 2 home,

Residents in both Phase 1 & 2 are not permitted to go on any social or welfare program. Unemployment, food stamps and other supplemental programs deter from gainful employment, productivity & community responsibility.

## ***Getting Fed the Word of God...***

Both Ranches attend Calvary Chapel Greeneville (Pastor Gary Hall) for Sunday morning & Wednesday evening services. They also attend a U-Turn for Christ Friday Night Service (Pastor Steve Nordgren) which is also held at Calvary Chapel Greeneville. U-Turn for Christ's Discipleship Study is held on-site at the Men's Ranch on Sunday evenings.
